

ACTS Operation Turkey 2009



Last year, ACTS distributed over 1,300 Operation Turkey Thanksgiving Food Baskets, ensuring that nearly 1,089 families in eastern Prince William County were able to celebrate with a Thanksgiving meal. This year we expect to feed nearly 2,100 families.

Three Ways to Help

1. Bring items to fill baskets

Each basket contains:

- 2 cans of corn 14-15 oz.
- 2 cans green beans 14-15 oz.
- 1 can baked beans 28 oz.
- 1 can sweet potatoes 40 oz.
- 1 large box muffin or biscuit mix**
- 1 box or bag stuffing 16 oz.
- 2 cans or jars gravy or pkgs. gravy mix
- 1 can cranberry sauce 16 oz.
- 2 boxes macaroni & cheese
- 1 box instant mashed potatoes 16 oz.**
- 1 can pumpkin pie mix

**We need extra boxes of muffin or biscuit mix and instant mashed potatoes. We always seem to run out of those items.

Please bring food to the garage door of the ACTS Family Services Center at 3900 ACTS Lane, Dumfries by November 19.
